Requirements	
Study Requirements	Eligible undergraduate students must have successfully completed a minimum of two semesters of study before commencing the exchange program. Upon completion of the exchange program, students are expected to return to their home university to finish their degree requirements.
GPA	Minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.
Language Proficiency	An English Proficiency Certificate is required for students from non-English-speaking countries with non-English-medium instruction. Minimum score: TOEFL:500, IELTS: 5.0, iBT: 70, TOEIC 500, ITP 500 or equivalent.

Course	Students will register for courses online under the guidance of their respective faculties. The 10-18 credits are permitted. Students wishing to enrol in more than 18 credits must obtain prior approval from both the Office of International Affairs (OIA) and their faculty. Important note: Students must register for a minimum of 50% of their total credits within their primary study program. For example, a student enrolled for 18 credits in



	International Relations (IR) must take at least 9 credits from the IR curriculum, while the remaining 9 credits may be selected from other available programs.

Restrictions	• Students can only enrol in one major or program during the admission process. • Cross-faculty course registration is permitted, but students should primarily focus on courses within their main major or program. • Cross-level course registration is not allowed. • Programs in the Faculty of Cultural Sciences are taught in a mix of English and Indonesian, with Indonesian being the primary language of instruction. • Students taking courses in Indonesian should have a sufficient level of Indonesian language proficiency. • The Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry is not available for exchange programs. • For Faculty of Economics and Business (FEB) students must enroll based on their level of study • The Indonesian Study / INCULS program is not included in the fee-waived exchange program. Students who apply for INCULS will be charged a fee (IDR 13,692,300 / semester)

Visa Information	
Application	Universitas Gadjah Mada will facilitate the visa application process. Students will be responsible for a visa fee detailed in their Letter of Offer. Once approved, the E-Visa will be sent directly to students from our Legal Permit team's email address (itas.oia@ugm.ac.id).
Fee	The visa fee for a 6-month to 1-year stay is IDR 7,600,000. (for exchange program) The visa fee for 2 months stay is IDR 2,000,000 (for short/summer/winter program)
Type	Exchange Students must use a Student Visa (index E30B) for their stay in Indonesia. Those who arrive on a different visa type must depart and re-enter Indonesia with the correct visa.
Exit Permit	Students planning to depart Indonesia at the end of their studies must report to the Office of International Affairs (OIA) at least two weeks prior to their departure to initiate the Exit Permit (EPO) process. Send your EPO request to itas.oia@ugm.ac.id .
